As we reflect on the journey so far, it is clear that the work of equality, diversity, and inclusion (EDI) in the Church is not a passing initiative—it is a Gospel imperative. Rooted in the life and teachings of Jesus, our call to justice, reconciliation, and dignity for all people remains central to our mission.

Thanks to the faithful efforts of UKME leaders and allies across our Diocese, we have seen meaningful progress: increased representation, courageous conversations, and a growing awareness that racial justice belongs to all of us. These are not just milestones—they are signs of transformation. But we must be clear: the journey is far from over. Ongoing commitment is essential. We need to embed inclusive practices in every layer of Church life, from recruitment to formation, from worship to governance. Unconscious bias training must move from the margins to the mainstream. Representation must be intentional, supported by leadership pathways that equip UKME clergy and laity to thrive.

This work is not optional. It is spiritual, structural, and deeply pastoral. It calls us to reflect the full diversity of God's kingdom and to create a Church where all are welcomed, valued, and empowered to serve

As one chapter ends and another begins, let us not grow weary. Let us renew our vision and press ontogether—in faith, courage, and hope.
